


ALL DOMESTIC CHICKENS ARE RELATED TO **GALLUS GALLUS**, THE RED JUNGLE FOWL.





HENS WILL LET THEIR BABIES HIDE UNDER THEIR WINGS IN RAIN ...



WE TOOK HER TO THE VET, WHO GAVE HER SOME MEDICINE, AND BROUGHT HER BACK HERE.



































WHEN THEY ARE ALLOWED TO LIVE NATURALLY, CHICKENS CAN LIVE AS LONG AS 20 YEARS!




THE FACTORY FARM WAY

BUT ON BIG FARMS, HENS RAISED TO LAY EGGS LIVE LESS THAN TWO YEARS . . .




